INFORMATION FOR THE APPLICANT

- All applicants for the 9th Grade must take the Scholarship/Entrance Exam on December 1, 2012 at 8:30 am.
- Applicants are encouraged to apply online for a discounted fee of \$50.00 at www.lschs.org/admissions
- **Applications are due by Friday, November 23, 2012.**
- Applications will be accepted up to and including the day of the exam; however, only applicants who apply by November 23, 2012 will receive written confirmation in the form of a room assignment card.
- **Completion of this application automatically registers a student for the Scholarship/Entrance Exam.**
- All applicants will be considered for academic scholarships based on exam performance, prior academic achievement, and teacher recommendations.
- All applicants are required to submit an essay titled "Why I Want To Attend La Salle," which should be attached to the application.
- A \$60.00 application fee must accompany all paper applications. Checks and money orders should be made payable to La Salle College High School. **Alternatively, students may apply online for a discounted fee of \$50.00 at www.lschs.org/admissions**
- All applicants are encouraged to "Spend A Day At La Salle" by registering online at www.lschs.org/vipday. Parents and students who encounter difficulties registering online can contact the Admissions Office at (215) 402-4800. An informal interview will take place during the student's visit to La Salle.
- All applicants must submit a Transcript Request Form along with a Recommendation Form to their school, who, in turn, will forward the requested information to La Salle College High School. All transcripts and recommendations must be received by the Office of Admissions by December 14, 2012.
- **The application process is not considered complete until:**
 1. The applicant has taken the Scholarship/Entrance Exam.
 2. The Office of Admissions is in receipt of the student's transcript.
 3. The Office of Admissions is in receipt of all teacher recommendations.
 4. The Office of Admissions is in receipt of all standardized test scores.

All applicants are encouraged to submit a school photo.
